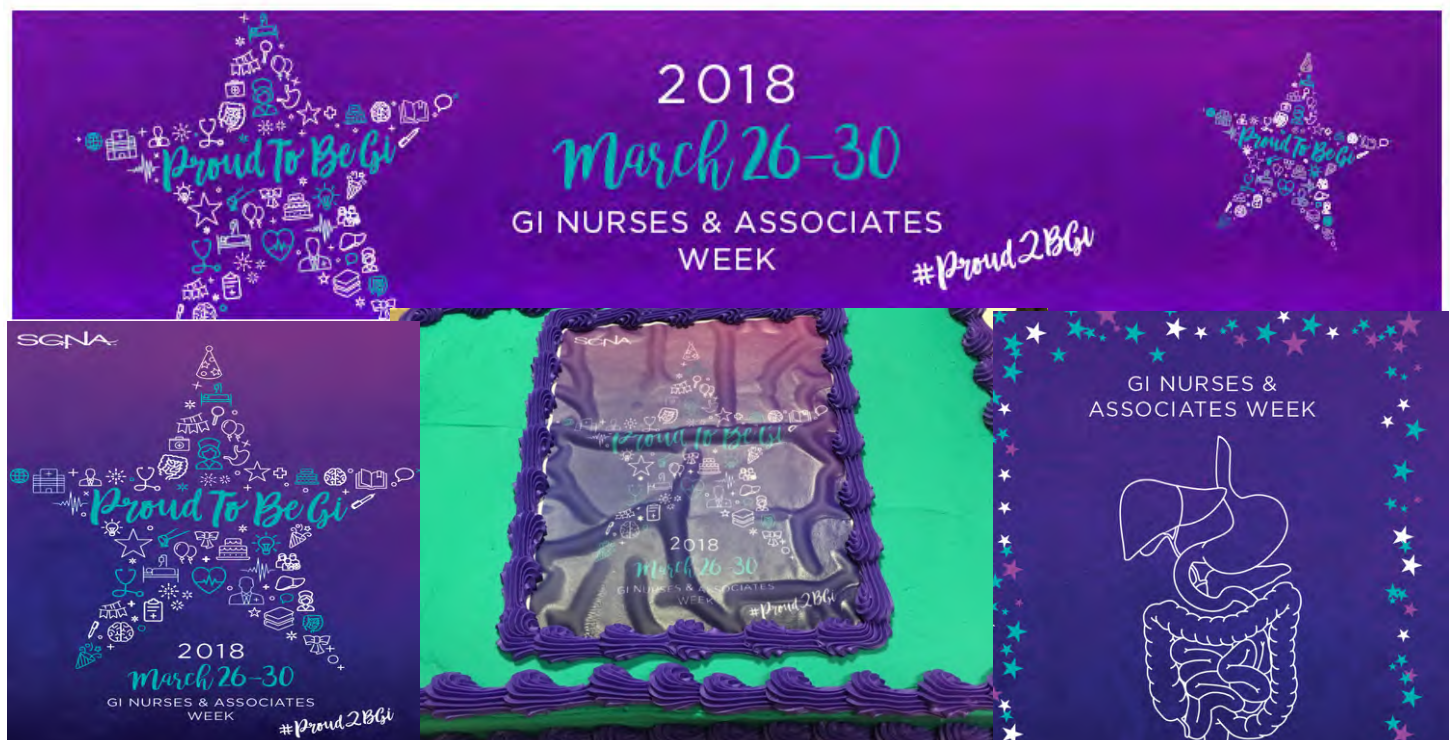


SPOTLIGHT ON JEANNIE STOA
